Admissions Updates

Deadlines for applications have changed as the demand for space in our freshman class increases. In order to accommodate all students that apply with exceptional grade point averages and SAT/ACT scores, we ask that you are mindful of these important deadlines. Please be sure to notify your students accordingly.

Please be mindful of the following deadlines:

- Preferred application periods
- Admission still open on space available basis
- \$200 tuition admission deposit due

Now – December 1
December 2 – March 1
May 1

As a seasonal counselor, you know that students who apply early have a better chance of being admitted. We strongly encourage students to apply by the preferred application dates.

Freshmen admission decisions are made based on the student's strong academic preparation and commensurate standardized test scores. Competition for places in the freshmen class is determined by the quality and extent of the applicant pool.

Apply Online:

- All students are encouraged to apply online at admissions.fiu.edu.
- Other than applying online, a student may print an application from the website and mail it to the Office of Admissions, or deliver it in person. The application fee is \$30.

Scholarships

FIU Rewards Academic Achievers

- All students accepted to FIU will automatically be considered for merit scholarships. A separate application is not required.
- Students should apply before **February 15** to be considered for scholarships.

The university has again been named one of the "10 Cool Colleges for Entrepreneurs" by *Fortune Small Business* magazine.

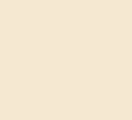
Our Executive MBA program was recently ranked #1 in Florida by the *Financial Times* (2006, 2007).
