• National Merit Finalist	\$5,000 per year, renewable for 3 years \$20,000 total	Students chosen by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation as a National Merit Finalist
• National Achievement Finalist	\$5,000 per year, renewable for 3 years \$20,000 total	Students chosen by the National Achievement Scholarship Corporation as a National Achievement Finalist
• National Hispanic Scholar	\$5,000 per year, renewable for 3 years \$20,000 total	Students chosen by the College Board as a National Hispanic Scholar
• Valedictorian (Florida students only)	\$3,500 per year, renewable for 3 years \$14,000 total	Selected Florida applicants who are named their school's Valedictorian. Minimum 1620 SAT (Verbal, Math, and Writing) or 24 ACT
• Salutatorian (Florida students only)	\$2,000 per year, renewable for 3 years \$8,000 total	Selected Florida applicants who are named their school's Salutatorian. Minimum 1620 SAT (Verbal, Math, and Writing) or 24 ACT
• Presidential (Florida students only)	\$2,500 per year, renewable for 3 years \$10,000 total	Selected Florida applicants with at least a 3.5 GPA and a minimum 1850 SAT (Verbal, Math, and Writing) or 28 ACT
• Academic Excellence (Florida students only)	\$1,000 per year, renewable for 3 years \$4,000 total	Selected Florida applicants with at least a 3.5 GPA and a minimum 1680 SAT (Verbal, Math, and Writing) or 25 ACT
• Academic Achievement (Non-Florida students only)	\$5,000 per year, renewable for 3 years \$20,000 total	Selected Non-Florida applicants with at least a 3.5 GPA and a minimum 1620 SAT (Verbal, Math, and Writing) or 24 ACT



* No separate application is necessary to compete for the above listed awards. Students should complete the admissions process by our preferred deadline of December 1st in order to compete. All award values are based on estimated 2008-2009 tuition & fees. Florida residents may also qualify for scholarships from the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program, adding to the total award value of their scholarship package at FIU. Scholarship funds are limited and decisions are made based on the student's strong academic preparation. Competition for scholarship awards is based on students' performance measured by GPA and commensurate test scores. Meeting minimum requirements for a scholarship does not guarantee selection.
