ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for admission to the PMBA program, prospective students must:

- Hold a four-year U.S. equivalent bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university.
- Be in good standing with all previously attended colleges and universities.
- 3. TOEFL or IELTS exam is required if a graduate is from a non-English speaking country. Achieve a minimum of 550 on the paper-based TOEFL, 213 on the computer-based TOEFL, 80 on the Internet-based TOEFL, or 6.5 on the IELTS exam.
- 4. GMAT/GRE Waiver
 - Applicant with two years of demonstrative work experience and success in completing other academic programs.
 - Applicant who has an undergraduate business or related degree (economics, hospitality management, etc.) with an upper-division grade point average (GPA) of 3.25 or above.
 - Applicant without an undergraduate business or related degree who has an upper-division GPA of 3.35 or above.
 - Applicant who has completed a graduate degree from an accredited university with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or above.
