ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for admission to the MSHRM program, prospective students must:

- Hold a 4-year Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution or, in the case of foreign students, from a well established institution of higher learning that it is authorized to grant degrees by appropriate authorities in that country.
- Grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 in the last 60 upperdivision credits (preferred).
- Score a minimum of 500 on the GMAT exam. GRE scores considered on an individual basis. May be waived for experienced applicants with strong academic credentials.
- 4. Be in good standing with all previously attended colleges and universities.
- 5. TOEFL or IELTS exam is required if a graduate is from a non-English speaking country. Achieve a minimum of 550 on the paper-based TOEFL, 213 on the computerbased TOEFL, 80 on the Internet-based TOEFL, or 6.5 on the IELTS exam.
